A recent nematode sampling of the soil material at the location described below has been processed and found to be negative for plant parasitic nematodes.

**California Mix Block, consisting of 7.0 acres, located at 1650 CR 470, Okahumpka.
(LAKE COUNTY)**

Your material, consisting of Canadian peat, bark, sawdust, sand, clay, perlite, vermiculite, composted horse bedding, and rice hulls, found at the location described above, meets the nematode certification requirements for **California certified potting mix**.

To remain approved, all plants, plant parts (except seed), soil, sawdust, mulch, manure, potting media or peat must be California nematode certified if brought within 100 feet of this approved pit or storage area and accompanied by a certificate.

Signs should be posted to prevent dumping of refuse in and around the storage area.

This is official notice that the number **1030** is your permanent nematode certification number. Please refer to this number for future inquiries.

Nurserymen are reminded that the nematode certification covering the soil material described in this letter shall remain in effect for a period of 1 year (12 months) from **December 3, 2014**, unless revoked for cause.
